- Scholarship award is \$5,000 and is non-renewable.
- Applicants may be pursuing any graduate program.
- Applicants must be enrolled at a local college or university for at least one semester
 prior to submitting an application, and will be actively enrolled in the 2024-2025
 academic year (as evidenced in the transcript and/or personal statement).
- Applicants must be a US citizen or US permanent resident.
- Applicants are required to provide information about their leadership potential, as illustrated by their engagement in social justice, advocacy, volunteer work and/or civic engagement that promotes equity, diversity and inclusion.
- The award recipient is required to make a presentation at an OCA-WI general membership meeting or another event about recipient's research study and/or advocacy, volunteer and/or civic engagement work.
- The scholarship recipient will receive a one-year student membership to OCA-WI and will be encouraged to attend OCA-WI activities.
- Application materials must include: a completed Application Form; two Letters of Recommendations; a Personal Statement; and a current Transcript (see next page for details).
